
EAPC ATLAS OF PALLIATIVE CARE IN EUROPE

The EAPC Atlas of Palliative Care in Europe is the result of the work of the EAPC Task Force on The Development of Palliative Care in Europe, started in 2003. This task force was developed with a core group of representative members of the organisations collaborating with the EAPC as Help the Hospices, The International Observatory on the End of Life Care (IOELC), The International Association of Hospice and Palliative Care (IAHPC) and The University of Navarra. The study has succeeded in compiling country reports for 43/52 participating countries, which results are presented in The Atlas in a very attractive way with tables and maps.

You will find the report, country by country, with an overview of the delivery of hospice and palliative care in different settings provided by the National Associations and also people identified as key persons in their countries. Health policy, accreditation of professionals and a selected bibliography are included in the sections of each country report. There are two version available of the Atlas: Atlas-book (336 colour printed pages) and Atlas CD-book (45 colour printed pages and CD).
