

Hotel Post***



The Hotel Post is a 3-star establishment and rich in tradition. In the old times the guest house "Zum weissen Ochsen" stood on this site where later the hotel "Zur Stadt London" was located. Personalities such as Mozart, Josef Haydn, Richard Wagner, Leos Janacek and Friedrich Nietzsche used to lodge there. In 1910 the hotel was bought by a Czech cooperative and known under the name of "Czech House in Vienna", until 1942, when, bowing to the political pressure, the name was changed to "Hotel Post", which it still carries today.

The Hotel Post is an establishment featuring modern comfort and conveniences, as well as traditional Viennese hospitality.

Due to its location right in the centre of the city, most of the sights are easy to reach by foot: St. Stephan's Cathedral, the Opera House, the Imperial Castle, the Parliament and the Town Hall. Also it is in walking distance to the major subway lines: U1 + U4 on Schwedenplatz, U1 + U3 on Stephansplatz,

U1, U2 + U4 on Karlsplatz

The hotel has 104 rooms, most of them provided with bath or shower and toilet. All rooms are also equipped with a hair-dryer, SAT-TV, direct telephone, radio and PC-modem-socket. The rooms are comfortably furnished and well-kept. Since the recently completed refurbishment, there are also modern business rooms with broadband internet access.
