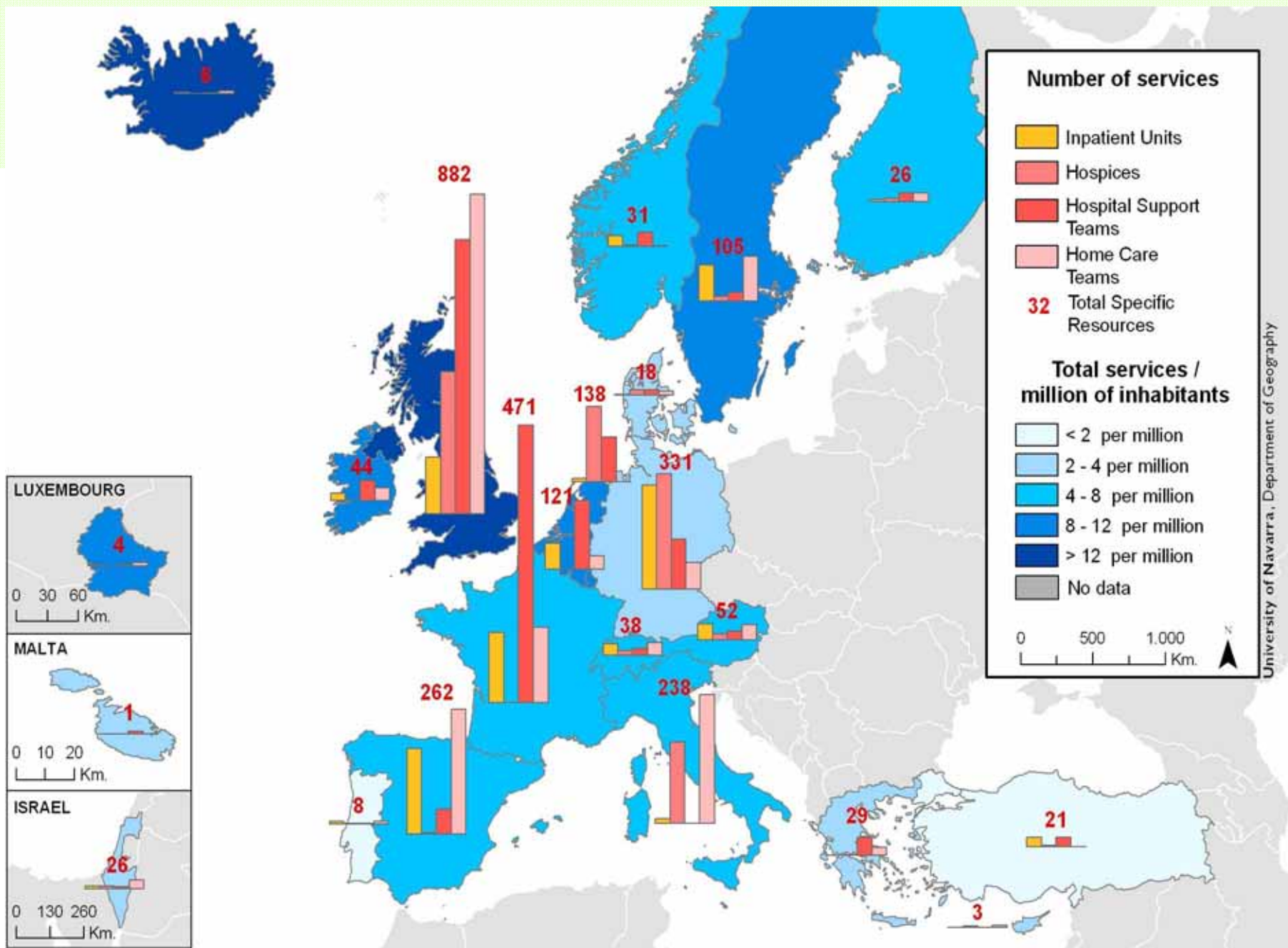


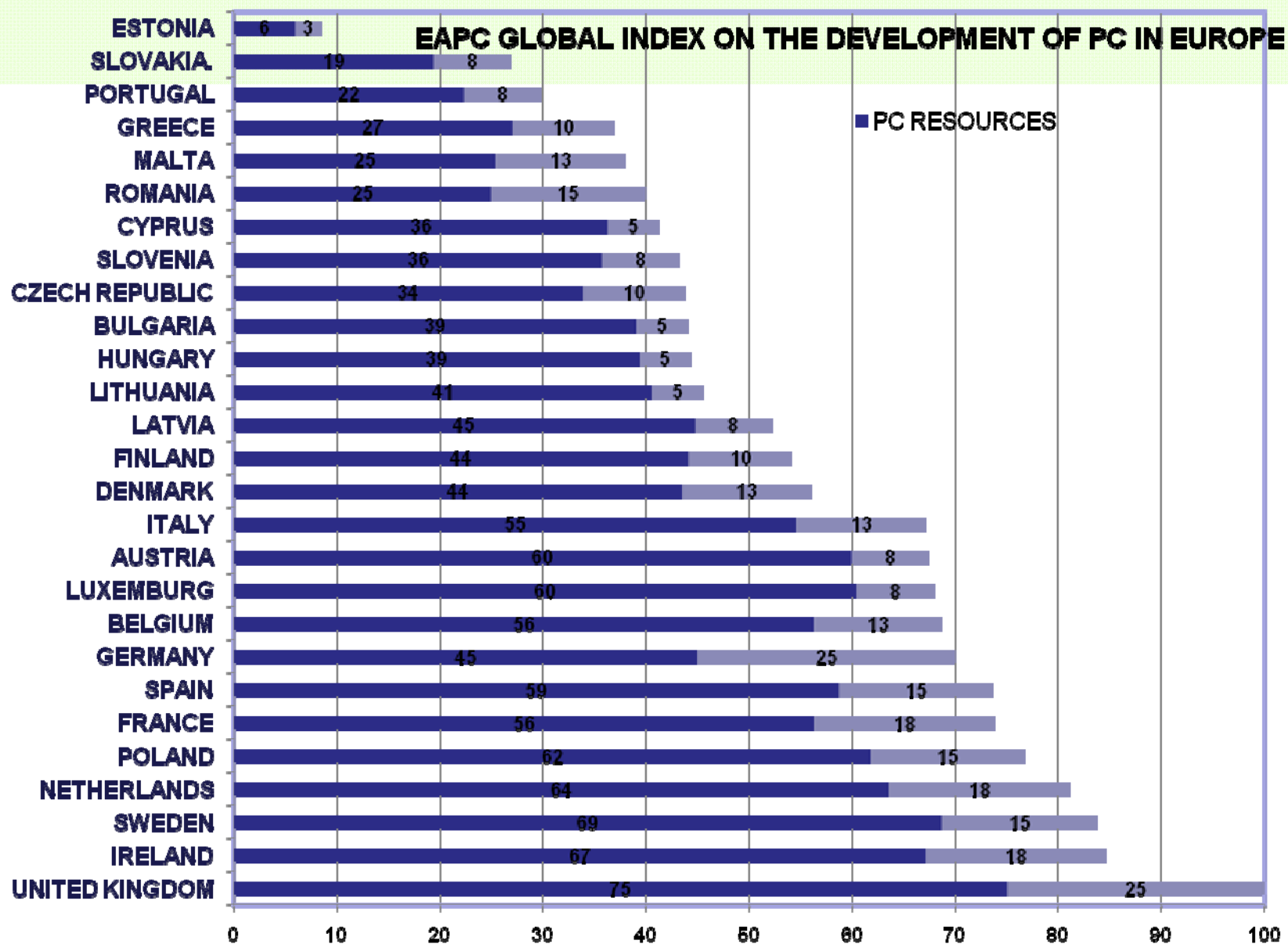

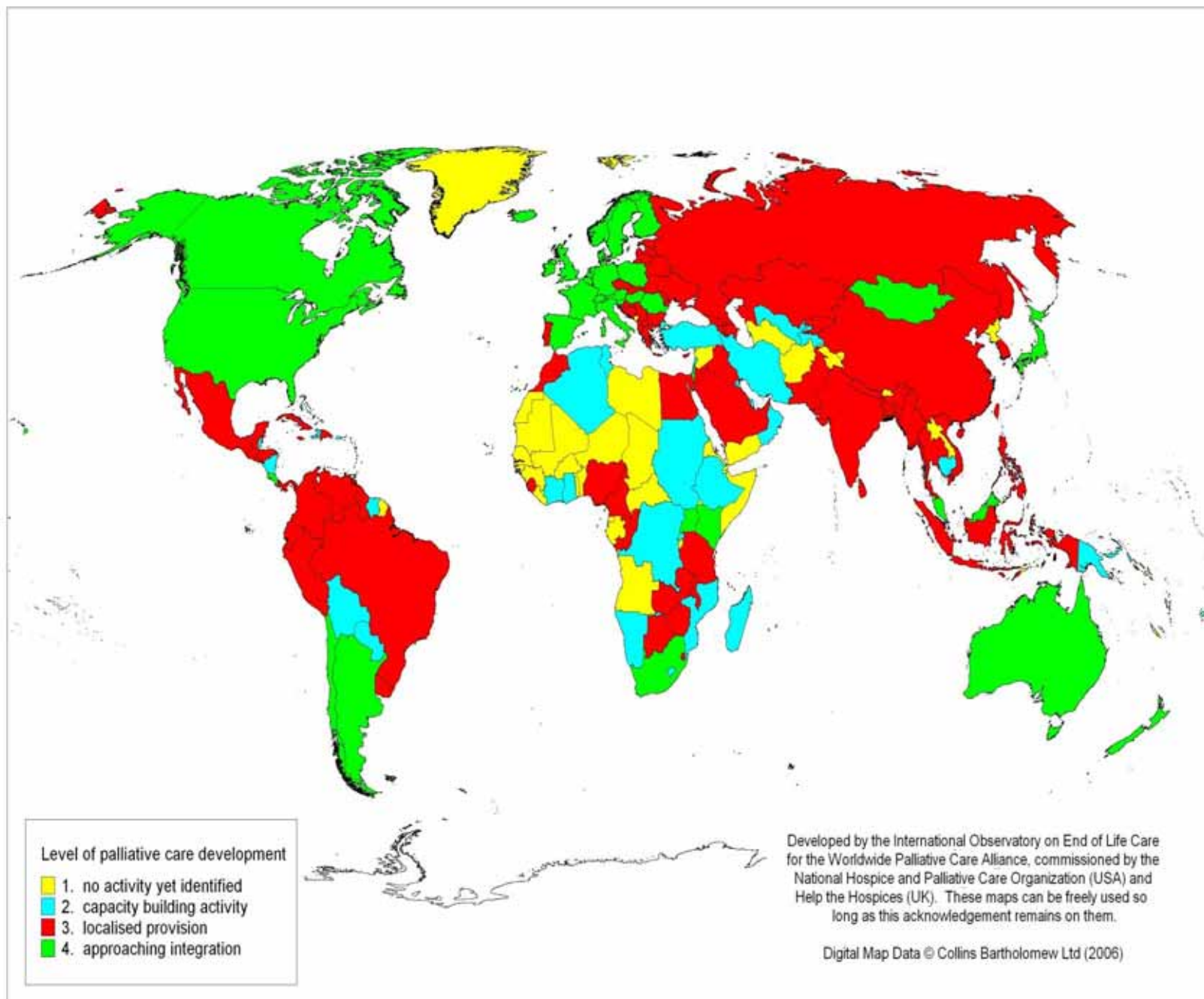

Background

Palliative care is an approach that improves the quality of life of patients and their families facing the problems associated with life-threatening illness, through the prevention and relief of suffering by means of early identification and impeccable assessment and treatment of pain and other problems, physical, psychosocial and spiritual. This definition of the World Health Organisation (WHO) (<http://www.who.int/cancer/palliative/definition/en/>, accessed on 27.02.2007) shows the full scope that palliative care providers have to cover.

However, in most services the provision of palliative care is far from optimal and in many countries and regions in and out of Europe, the development of palliative care is hindered by barriers and obstacles. In spite of tremendous engagement of palliative care specialists and volunteers, countless patients at the end of life suffer from treatable pain, anxiety and other symptoms, social isolation and existential solitude. Results from a recent survey on development of Palliative Care in Europe show vast differences in the state of development among European countries. (Conteno C.
