Example Czech Republic

Short description of the underlying problems that the commitments are aimed at

Ill-defined conditions and of providing and refunding palliative care within legal system.

Description of commitments

Defining and setting down conditions for providing and refunding palliative care within the legal system. Negotiating with deputies of government and insurance companies.

Goal, measurement of success and time

Result will be declared in a code within 12 months.

Example: Norway NFPM

THE BUDAPEST COMMITMENTS – project document Description of commitments

- 1. To promote the Norwegian standard of palliation and have it implemented.
- 2. To establish palliative medicine as its own disiplin with a foundation in different specialities
- 3. Improve the education of medical students in the field of palliation

Goal, measurement of success and time

- 1. Ongoing. Will be finally implemented in 2008
- 2. The process has started, and will continue during the next 5 years
- 3. The medical students in Trondheim have evaluated the education in oncology and palliation to be very good. They have both lectures, problem based learning (PBL) groups and weakly bedside education involving patients. We will try to implement this model also for the medical education in Bergen, Oslo and Tromsø.
