## European Parliament resolution on combating cancer in the enlarged EU

Calls the EC, Council and the Member States to:

Take appropriate action on prevention, early detection, diagnosis, treatment including palliative care, in order to reduce the significant approaching increase in the burden of cancer...



## European Parliament resolution on combating cancer in the enlarged EU

Furthermore, calls on the Council and Commission to formulate a comprehensive cancer control strategy addressing the basic cancer control factors:

Prevention, early detection, diagnosis, treatment and follow up and palliative care



#### EU's main instrument for funding research



### Framework Programme 6th Palliative care results

- >2 projects on palliative care
  - ➤ Normolife: Development of new therapeutic substances and strategies for treatment of pain in patients with advance stages of cancer
  - ➤ EPCRC: Improved treatment of pain, depression and fatigue Identifying genes and genetic variation to opioid responses and risk to develop cachexia: To improve classification and assessment: to develop internet assessment methods for quidelines



### Framework Programme 7th End of life care results

### 24 projects negotiated for funding 2 projects on end of life care

- ➤ OPCARE 9: A European Collaboration to optimize research for the care of cancer patients in the last days of life
- ➤ PRISMA: reflecting the positive diversities of European priorities for research and measurement in the end of life care



### The Innovative Medicines Initiative



#### IMI directly aiming at:

Removal of the major bottlenecks in drug development, to which research is the key (safety, efficacy, knowledge management, education & training)

#### Main principles:

Set up as a € 2 billion Public-Private Partnership, founded and financed jointly by EFPIA and EC via Joint Undertaking (Art.171)

Shall be an open structure supporting research collaborations involving all stakeholders: Industry, SMEs, academia, clinics, patient organisations, etc., following open calls and peer review



### The Innovative Medicines Initiative 1st Call for proposal on 30 April 2008

### Budget: around €123 millions

+ non-monetary contributions by the research based companies that are members of EFPIA at least equal to the financial contribution of the Community

IMI 1st Call: 18 Call Topics
